

## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pune University and other University students should look **carefully their counseling date and respective merit number** called for M.Sc. admission in Chemistry in above table.
2. To secure the admission, attendance for counseling is compulsory. In case you cannot come personally, you can send your representative on that day. The representative should be competent to take all decisions regarding selection of branches (viz. Inorganic, Organic, Biochemistry, Physical & Analytical) and allied aspects. Failing to attend the counseling would result in cancellation of your claim.  
**We call more students for counseling, it does not mean your admission will be sure.**
3. 70 seats (open + reservation students) are offered to the students from Pune University and they are only on the basis of (a) B.Sc. Chemistry marks and (b) Entrance Test Marks, with equal weightage to (a) and (b).  
 30 seats are offered to open and reserved category students of other universities only on the basis of Entrance Test Marks.  
 (3% seats are reserved for Physically handicapped students as per Maharashtra Government rule)

4. List of **original documents** to be produced for verification at the time of counseling:
  - a) All original certificate / marklist 10<sup>th</sup> std above education **OR** domicile certificate of state of Maharashtra (**Required compulsory**)

- b) Original marklist of F.Y.B.Sc., S.Y.B.Sc., T.Y.B.Sc.
  - c) Caste certificate
  - d) Caste validity certificate (if available)
  - e) Creamy layer and non-creamy layer certificates required for NT (C) , NT (D) , and OBC students.
5. **Fees for non-professional course** i.e. Organic, Inorganic, Physical, Biochemistry, are approx. Rs. 5,297/- (Within Maharashtra State) and approx. Rs. 7,697,- (Out of Maharashtra State)  
**Fees for professional course** i.e. Analytical Chemistry Rs. 10,382/- (Within Maharashtra State) and approx. Rs. 15,182/- (Out of Maharashtra State)  
**Please note that fees have to be paid immediately in cash on the counseling day. Seat will be secured in the University Department of Chemistry only after payment of fees.**
6. For the admissions to the **Hostel on the University campus**, a separate application form is required to be filled after getting the admission. **Only 30% of the hostel seats will be allotted to the students from outside universities on the basis of merit only.** Few seats for Hostel are also available for earn and learn scheme students. The admission to the Hostel are done only after the admission procedure is complete.
7. For any queries, immediately contact at Chemistry Department, University of Pune. During counseling time such changes will not be considered.
8. **Teaching will start from 20<sup>h</sup> July, 2009.**
