5. List of **Original documents** to be produced for verification at the time of counseling.
 - a. All original certificate / marklist 10th std above education OR domicile of state Maharashtra. (Required compulsory)
 - b. Original Marklist of F.Y.B.Sc., S.Y. B.Sc. and T.Y. B.Sc.
 - c. Caste certificate
 - d. Caste Validity certificate (if available)
 - e. Creamy layer and non creamy layer certificates required for NT(C), NT (D) and OBC students.
6. Fees for non professional course i.e. Inorganic, Physical, Biochemistry are approx. Rs. 5297/- (Within Maharashtra State)
For professional course i.e. Analytical Chemistry Rs. 10,382/- (Within Maharashtra state)
